

## Restoration - Anderson House



This four square house (on the left) was built in 1905 for Charles Fjerestad by carpenter B. Thompson and crew of Harvey. He added a porch to his kitchen in November of 1906. Hans Opsahl did the work. In May of 1913 he sold his home to Olaf Anderson.



Olaf died of a heart attack in 1931. His widow Caroline (Lena) continued to live in this house and raised beautiful flowers.

Lena lived until 1971, however she did move to Minneapolis to live with her daughter for the last year or two of her life.



The house remained empty after Lena moved out. It was purchased in 2003? And renovation work has begun. It has new shingles on the roof, and reinforcements as well.



The porch was rebuilt to its original specs, and work has begun on preparing the exterior for paint in the fall of 2008.



Painting of the exterior was begun in 2011. The scaffolding is still in place, as exterior painting is still in process.
