

Restoration - Vang Lutheran Church



The Church was built in 1906. The photo was taken at the Dedication Service June 26, 1910.



This picture was taken sometime after 1910, when the brick school was constructed. Notice the exterior with grey color with the white trim.



The inside of the church as it looks today. Note the ceiling lights which were originally lit with kerosene. The stain glass windows were added in the late 1950s as memorials.



This sign was placed on site in 2006, the 100th anniversary of the building. The church was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2001



The church continues to be maintained with services held regularly.

A chancel reed pump organ vintage 1907 was recently added to the interior. The organ is very similar to the original instrument used during the first years of the church. It is used for worship services regularly.
